



## Terms and conditions

1. The grainchain.com Inspire! competition is open to all teachers of students aged 11-14 years located in England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales. Student teachers in the UK, in their final year who are teaching students aged 11-14 years are also permitted to enter. 2. Multiple entries are allowed per school and per teacher.
3. To enter for an award you must complete and submit an entry form. The entry form is available online.
4. The information provided on the entry form must be correct to the best of your knowledge. You warrant that you are entitled to send all details and materials relating to your entry to the organisers and that all materials are original and do not infringe any third party right.
5. Entries must satisfy the criteria of the competition by showcasing excellence in the delivery of teaching according to curriculum requirements.
6. Judging criteria for the competition include: promote practical foodwork with flour, as well as other ingredients; be aimed at 11-14 year olds; link with the curriculum in your region of the UK; include student feedback.
7. Any photographs of students included in entries must receive guardian/parental permission. Permission will be requested after the closing date. If guardian/parental permission is not granted, the entries will be invalid.
